Question 1

Your organization is preparing a project proposal to bid for funding. You are leading the formulation team, and you would like them to apply the logical framework analysis (LFA) during conceptualization of the proposal.

- a). Which logical framework analysis (LFA) line of reasoning would you present to them?

- b). Describe the differences between a <u>problem tree</u> and an <u>objective tree</u>. (10 marks)
- c). Using a template for a strategy analysis structure, present an immediate objective (purpose) and its appropriate strategies. (10 marks)

Question 2

In conducting an evaluation of a community health program, the evaluators have agreed to use interview methods.

- a). Explain the guidelines that the evaluators should use in constructing an effective questionnaire. (15 marks)
- b). Describe the differences between a semi-structured interview and unstructured interview. (10 marks)

Question 3

The team you are leading have been tasked to develop a Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Indicator Plan for the HIV Prevention and Treatment program.

- a). Explain the differences between:
- an <u>indicator</u> and a <u>unit of measure</u>? (4 marks), and a <u>target</u> and a <u>baseline value</u>? (4 marks)
- b). Provide two examples of <u>non-directional indicators</u> for a Malaria Prevention and Control program. (2 marks)
- c). Describe the components you would consider in developing a M&E Indicator plan.

Question 4

The Director of Public Health in your County has asked you to guide the Health Surveillance team in selecting appropriate evaluation designs for use at the District Health Survey Bureau.

- a). Describe the differences between <u>Experimental design</u> and <u>Quasi-experimental design</u>. (10 marks)
- b). Explain the various stages of an evaluation design process that you would present to the health surveillance team. (15 marks)

Question 5

Your organization needs a monitoring and evaluation (M&E) system. Your director has approached you being the M&E manager, to prepare and present to the Management team the considerations for developing the M&E system. Discuss the following:

- a). The rationale for the monitoring and evaluation (M&E) system. (10 Marks)
- b). Principles of the M&E system. (10 Marks)
- c). The key dimensions of a successful M&E system. (5 Marks)

Question 6

You are preparing to conduct the endline evaluation of a 5-year donor funded HIV/AIDS project, and you are the Lead Consultant.

- a). Describe the data collection considerations you would make during the evaluation preparation.(15 Marks)
- b). Explain how you would ensure data quality control during the evaluation. (10 Marks)
