CASE SCENARIO

Mrs. Pascal is a 78-year-old lady with severe arthritis who lives alone in South Mattan. Mrs. Pascal slipped whilst walking down her stairs, broke a wrist and sprained her left ankle. She was admitted to a local general hospital. She is currently suffering from depression and is not able to carry out activities such as bathing and cooking due to her condition. At the hospital, Pascal was visited by a social worker. During the assessment, the social worker asked Pascal about her financial and support network.

Through assessment, a social worker realized that Mrs. Pascal has dementia. The Social worker also established that Mrs. Pascal currently has no care and support plan in place and made contact with the local authority and a nurse to arrange an intensive needs assessment.

The local authority undertakes the financial assessment which finds out that Mrs. Pascal's finances are above the limit for financial support from the local authority. The authority provides her with information and advice about options available to her on home based care and support services. Mrs. Pascal expresses extreme nervousness about seeking placement on her own as she has struggled with managing her personal finances in recent times and does not have any family member who is able to support her. The hospital nurse in collaboration with a social worker and the local authority concluded that she has eligible needs which will be best met in a care home setting.

After a consultation, both Mrs. Pascal and her local authority agree that support with arranging and managing a care placement would be beneficial for her well-being and would adequately meet her eligible needs. The authority arranges for Mrs. Pascal to meet a trusted brokerage organization that discusses her needs and arranges a contract with a care home on behalf of Mrs. Pascal that she is very happy with. She is later enrolled in an elderly homebased care agency where you are a caregiver.

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
