- 2. Parental consent must be obtained when counselling a student who is under the legal age.

 Mention FOUR important reasons for seeking parental consent. (4 Marks)
- 3. Assessment in guidance and counselling is critical to gather the client's information. Identify FOUR types of assessments that can be administered by a school counsellor. (4 Marks)
- 4. School counsellors at times find it difficult to attend supervision. State FOUR factors that hinder school counsellors from attending supervision. (4 Marks)
- 5. Caroline has been counselling Peter who is a student in one of the local secondary schools for some time, however, she has found it challenging to terminate the counselling services. State FOUR consequences that may result from not terminating the services. (4 Marks)
- 6. Psycho-education is an essential component of a treatment plan in counselling. Identify FOUR reasons why psycho-education is used in guidance and counselling. (4 Marks)
- Counselling skills are interpersonal and technical traits that a counsellor uses to better understand and listen to their clients. List FOUR skills a counsellor is required to use to enable concreteness. (4 Marks)
