- 5. Complex trauma can affect the society in a multitude of ways. Highlight FOUR impacts of trauma on the society (4 marks)
- 6. Maria had a fight with her husband who chopped off her two hands. Outline FOUR psychological symptoms she is likely to experience (4 marks)
- 7. Jimmy, a trauma client has been undergoing counselling in your center for the last two months and you intend to terminate the sessions. State FOUR considerations you would make before the termination (4 marks)
- 8. Complex trauma can affect individuals in a multitude of ways. Name FOUR most common External causes of trauma (4 marks)

 - b) Describe FIVE effects of trauma on children (10 marks)
- 13. Trauma-focused cognitive behavior therapy is a therapy for children and adolescents to recover from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and other trauma related challenges.
 - a) Discuss FIVE reasons why adolescents or children with PTSD or trauma related challenges should seek counselling intervention (10 Marks)
 - b) Explain FIVE suicidal warning signs you can note in a traumatized client (10 Marks)
