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TASK 1: Code the following medical conditions;

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- a) Femoral neck fracture
- b) Emergency CS due HTN
- c) Chronic Obstructive Asthma
- d) Colorectal cancer

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e) TB of the lung

f) Gastro-esophageal Reflux Disease

TASK 2: Draw a diagnostic index card using the following scenarios.

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Scenario 1: 7-year-old female on 29/12/2025 presented with fever, productive cough, and difficulty breathing for 3 days. Chest X-ray confirmed right lower lobe pneumonia treated with IV antibiotics (ceftriaxone), oxygen therapy, and supportive care. Patient showed significant improvement by date 01/01/2026 she was discharged with oral antibiotics and follow-up appointment scheduled.

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Scenario 2: 52-year-old male admitted on date 10/01/2026 via emergency department with severe chest pain radiating to left arm, diaphoresis, and elevated cardiac enzymes. ECG showed ST-elevation in anterior leads he underwent emergency percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) with stent placement. Post-procedure recovery complicated by mild heart failure requiring adjustment of medications. Transferred to specialized cardiac rehabilitation facility on 18/01/2026 for continued monitoring and cardiac rehabilitation program.
