2. You have received complaints from the linked health facility regarding the decreased uptake of available health services. Suggest FOUR strategies to address this issue. (4 Marks)
3. List THREE sites you would consider for a reproductive health service outreach. (3 Marks)
4. Imani, a palliative care organization for diabetic patients, has asked you to help enroll eligible beneficiaries. Underline THREE priority groups you can consider for enrolment. (3 Marks)
5. Name FOUR health services that can be offered during integrated community health outreach. (4 Marks)
6. Identify FOUR legal requirements for organizing an integrated community outreach. (4 Marks)
7. Name FOUR medical covers that the Ministry of Health strives to include in the Universal Health Coverage. (4 Marks)
8. There was a low turnout at the integrated outreach despite the mobilisation efforts. Record FOUR factors that could have contributed to the low turnout. (4 Marks)
9. The stakeholders of the malaria project you are implementing have requested an update on the project's progress. State THREE forums you can use to share this information. (3Marks)
10. List FOUR determinants of health. (4 marks)
11. The referral process is only complete when level one service providers are involved through counter-referral to the community. Underline FOUR reasons for the counter-referral. (4 Marks)

a) Explain FOUR impacts of this problem. (8 Marks)

b) Suggest SIX strategies the government can use to manage the problem. (12 marks)
