2. While conducting a risk assessment in a local clinic, you observe poor storage of sharp objects.
 - a) Mention two hazards that could arise from this situation. (2 Marks)
 - b) Identify two methods of reporting hazards according to MOH protocols. (2 Marks)
3. You notice that new health volunteers are unaware of how to handle minor injuries.
 - a) Enumerate Two ways to identify needed OSH-related training. (2 Marks)
 - b) State Two OSH guidelines relevant to basic first aid handling. (2 Marks)
4. A community member is injured while sweeping a public park. You are first on scene. Highlight Four methods on how you would conduct a quick scene size-up. (4 Marks)
5. In a first aid demonstration, a student is unsure of how to apply PPE.
 - a) Identify Two personal protective equipment items used in first aid (2 Marks)
 - b) State two reasons for using PPE during first aid. (2 Marks)
6. While assisting a casualty, you realize they need advanced care. Mention Four indicators that a casualty's condition is deteriorating. (4 Marks)
7. During a school safety audit, you are asked to assess risk prevention measures. Highlight Four ways hazards are identified during assessments. (4 Marks)
8. You provide first aid to a person who has fainted.
 - a) Outline TWO first aid measures you would take. (2 Marks)
 - b) Mention TWO steps to monitor their condition afterward. (2 Marks)

9. After completing first aid, you are responsible for area cleanup. Enumerate FOUR steps to safely dispose of used materials. (4 Marks)
10. You are called to assist a child experiencing trauma after a road accident.
- a) Define psychological first aid (PFA). (2 Marks)
 - b) Name Two assessment tools used in psychological first aid. (2 Marks)
