Joseph is 11 years old, in Grade 5 at Nyamusi Primary School and second born in a single parent family of five. His mother is a casual laborer and takes any job that is available including working in a quarry. Joseph's other siblings are girls, and he has always been told by his mother that he is the "man of the house". He feels proud of the confidence his mother has in him. Joseph loves his mother very much and he feels sad because of the hardships she faces daily. Joseph also feels that he is old enough to drop out of school and get a job to assist his mother financially. His mother wants him to study hard and become a doctor in order get them out of poverty. He feels frustrated and angry when he is asked to go to school. Her mother brought him for a counselling session complaining of his low concentration in class, reluctance to wake up early for school, withdrawn, and complaining of wanting to change school.
