3. You are called upon to by a local Non-Governmental Organization to carryout community health assessment in Mini community, with an aim of offering health education. Highlight FOUR health needs that would likely suit your choice. [4 Marks]
4. You have been called upon by a local healthcare facility to help conduct community health education. Name FOUR key objectives of interest in the Community that will guide this exercise. [4Marks]
5. Highlight FOUR common ailments you are supposed to manage as a community health worker. [4 Marks]
6. A local Non-Governmental Organization has contracted you to carry out disease surveillance in Neno village. State FOUR areas of health interest that will be fundamental during this exercise. [4 Marks]
7. Kopa village has been identified to have high rates of malnutrition among infants. Propose THREE methods of nutritional assessments. [3 Marks]
8. Recommend FOUR health-related licensing bodies that ensure quality health service delivery to the community. [4 Marks]

- b. Elaborate FOUR uses of public health surveillance. [8 Marks]

13. Mituri village has been identified to have high prevalence of common ailments. You have been selected by a local NGO to train the CHVs on essential drugs that needs to be maintained in their kits.

- a. Identify FOUR factors to consider when restocking a CHV kit. [4 Marks]
- b. For proper management of patients, it's important for a community health worker to be familiar with the essential drugs and supplies in the CHV kit. Explain EIGHT essential drugs or supplies contained in the CHV kit. [16 Marks]

14. After analysis of community health needs assessment data, the findings showed that most community members do not have access to safe water. Poor sanitation and hygiene were also observed during data collection. To address these issues at the grassroots level, recommendation was that all community health workers should be trained on water, sanitation and hygiene.
