INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATE:

Mr. X is a 32 years old male diagnosed with HIV virus about three years ago. He is married and has two children. He works in the city and his family lives hundreds of kilometers' away in a remote village. For three months, Mr. X has been taking antiretroviral drugs D4T/3TC/EFV (STAVUDINE PLUS LAMIVUDINE) and (EFAVIRENZ). His wife Mrs. X is a member of a religious sect that does not embrace conventional medical treatment but rather prefers prayers for divine healing. She is not aware of her HIV status; she keeps complaining of flu-like symptoms but she believes she will receive divine healing. As a community health assistant, in your routine household visits you come across her case and she consents for HIV screening.

1. You are required to perform the following tasks

Task 1: Educate Mrs. X on myths and misconceptions of HIV/AIDS

Task 2: Using tool, A, screen Mrs. X for HIV.

Task 3: Use the information obtained from tool A to educate the above client on the importance of HIV Testing and Counselling.
