EXCERPT

Brandon is the eldest son in a family of four. His mother Esther married Jackson, a lawyer, after Brandon was born. Since childhood, Brandon has noticed that his younger siblings, Edwin, Charles, and James, are showered with gifts and attention by their father, while he receives no such treatment. When Brandon joined secondary school, his school fees were not paid, leading to him being sent home. Hurt, rejected, and angry, Brandon blamed his mother for not protecting him from his stepfather's neglect. One morning, in desperation, Brandon stole Jackson's music system, sold it, and used the money to pay his school fees before returning to school. Furious about the theft, Jackson called the police and had them go to the school to arrest Brandon. Brandon

insists that his stepfather is wealthy and could easily afford to pay for his education. To resolve the conflict, Brandon, Jackson, and his mother Esther have been referred for counselling.
